Details for your consideration

There are some required components of this program we want all candidates to be familiar with as they go through the application process.

1. AmeriCorps is a Federal Institution, to qualify for AmeriCorps service all applicants must create an account with AmeriCorps which will require either citizenship or permanent legal resident status.
2. To qualify for AmeriCorps service, and to join YouthPower365's team, all candidates must pass both Federal and State background checks.
3. Part of AmeriCorps Service is representing AmeriCorps while participating in the program. Wearing a uniform daily is part of the position and is required. All uniform items will be provided to you.
4. The housing offered is single occupancy, meaning only the person serving in the position is eligible for it (no partners, children etc.).
5. There are no pets allowed in the housing. This is in consideration of the lease we have for the units, and of possible allergies.
6. The service term is roughly one year, please consider this commitment carefully before moving forward.
