EXTENDED LEARNING CONFERENCE

YouthPower365 is hosting the inaugural PwrHrs Extended Learning Conference from November 13th-November 15th, 2019. The conference will bring together more than 200 educators, out-of-school learning practitioners, community leaders, teachers, funders, and policy-makers from across the United States for collaboration in order to strengthen and promote the contributions of afterschool and summer learning programs to the educational outcomes of children and youth. Its aim is to move the needle toward a nation where quality out-of-school opportunities are available to all children in need no matter where they live.

Designed to inform, inspire, and empower, with a special emphasis for those serving rural communities, the conference will focus on four tracks, including best practices, evaluation, the power of partnerships and program innovation through shared experience. The PwrHrs Extended Learning model will be used as a launching point for the exchange of ideas around the design, implementation and evaluation of out-of-school programs that support academic, social and emotional learning outcomes. We'll discuss the enabling partnership models that sustain them and foster dialogue around collaboration needed for policy influence and advocacy at local, state, and national levels.

Participant engagement, co-creation and shared expertise will be the guiding principles of this convening, and will be achieved through interactive breakout sessions, renowned keynote speakers, and opportunities to engage with PwrHrs programs and teachers during site visits. All attendees will have a stake in the conference outcomes, created by working throughout conference sessions to create collaborative curriculum resources well suited for extended learning in rural communities.
